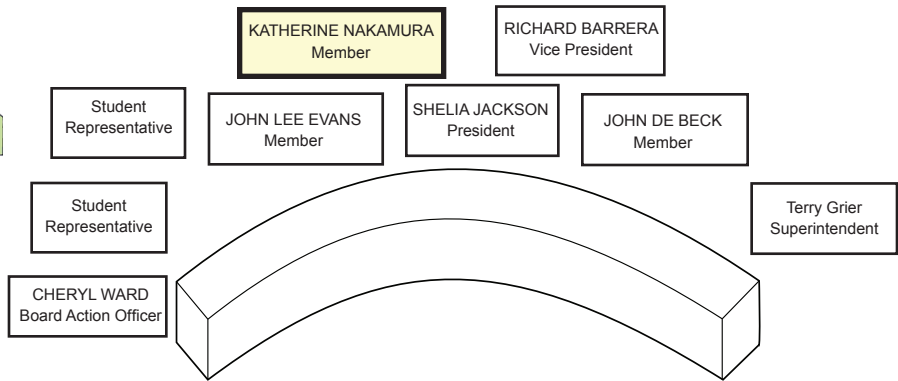
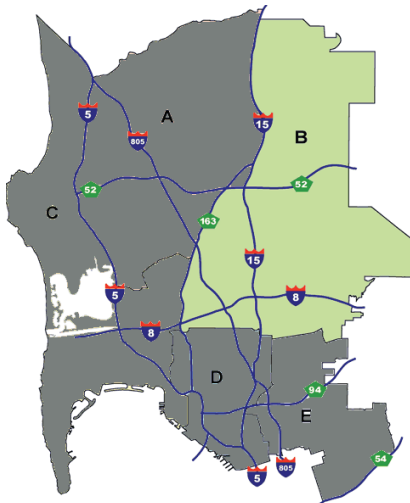


Katherine Nakamura, Member District B Term Expires December 2010
