PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: San Diego Unified School District and Mary Ehrenworth

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: The contract being submitted for board approval will provide consultant services of Mary Ehrenworth to work with the District's Institute for Learning staff. Consultant will provide the following services: coaching staff developer at school sites, planning, preparation and presentation of literacy workshops, planning instruction with teachers, consulting services to individual school sites, meeting individual needs at school sites including modeling and debriefing with teachers and site administration.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Mary Ehrenworth is an educational consultant and curriculum developer in literacy and content area literacy. In her twelve years of teaching, she has taught writing from writing workshop in second grade, to freshman composition at the college level. She is on the staff of the New York University Writing Institute, and is a literacy staff developer for Community School District Two, New York City. She is also a consultant for the education department of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York. Her forthcoming book, entitled 'Looking to Write: Stories for Teachers and Children Inspired by the Visual Arts', will be published by Heinemann in 2003. She has also published in the journals 'Language Arts' and 'English Journals.'
