Recommendation(s):

The Superintendent recommends the Board of Education approve the request for Riley School to implement a single-track year-round program as shown in Appendix A.

Summary of Previous Board of Education Discussion and Action: None

Summary of Key Issue(s):

A year-round schedule will eliminate the long summer break during which students with Emotional Disturbance (ED) regress, both academically and behaviorally. It will also allow more frequent and shorter school breaks allowing the students to relax and regroup more frequently and, students who attend intersession will have an equal amount of educational time in a school year identical to those attending a traditional school offering summer school.

Fiscal Analysis:

School site staff will see a reduction in contract days by moving from a traditional to a single-track year-round program. Make-up days will be offered to those staff members affected during times identified by the school site in collaboration with Human Resource Services.

This request to move from a traditional calendar to a single-track calendar is a cost neutral conversion. This conversion must remain in effect for a minimum of three years. In the event the school requests to return to a traditional calendar at the conclusion of the third year, the transition year costs must be paid by the school site (Administrative Procedure 4017, Section C.3.)
