### Summary of Key Issue(s):

San Diego City Schools continues its efforts to be accountable to community requests regarding the naming of new schools built through Proposition MM funds. The school name included in this report has been submitted to the School Names Committee by a science teacher at Thurgood Marshall Middle School after two separate comprehensive community outreach efforts to the schools and communities of Mira Mesa and Scripps Ranch. The community groups have been actively working with district staff to collaboratively name schools in their communities that reflect the culture, individuality and spirit of that particular neighborhood. As we build new schools, the district will continue to solicit community input. The district values listening to the communities we serve and will continue to approve their school name choices whenever possible.
