AGREEMENT SUMMARY: Agreement between the San Diego Unified
School District and Volunteer San Diego to
provide assistance to teachers with planning and
implementing service learning activities.

TERM: July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005.

AMOUNT OF FUNDING: \$6,600.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This agreement begins the eighth year of a contract
relationship with CONSULTANT. The
CONSULTANT will promote service (students
volunteering in the community) as a community
outreach effort for classroom teachers; integrate
service learning curriculum with district standards;
provide volunteer opportunities for students through
community-wide service events; provide mini-grant
and small grant writing opportunities for schools;
provide service learning consulting, orientations,
classroom presentations and training for teachers
and students; provide a Guide to Youth Volunteer
Opportunities to schools and students; supports the
efforts of the schools by tracking volunteer hours to
document on report cards; provide technical
assistance to agencies interested in working with
schools; support ongoing community partnerships
with organizations; and provide budget
management.
