PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: San Diego Unified School District and the San Diego County Office of Education, Region IX Migrant Education Program

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: The San Diego County Office of Education, Region IX Migrant Education Program will continue to provide quality supplementary educational and support services to identified migrant students.

TERM: July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005

AMOUNT OF FUNDING: The district does not incur any costs with support of the Migrant Education Program.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: N/A

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Migrant Education Program is a federally funded program, authorized through the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, designed to provide quality supplementary educational and support services to identified migrant students. The San Diego County Office of Education and the district have worked collaboratively for years to provide support to families in the Migrant Education Program.

Rational for Ratification: The processing of this contract was delayed because the final documentation from the San Diego County Office of Education was not provided at a time that would have permitted its submission prior to July 1, 2004.
