

EXPLANATION OF RATIFICATION OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND
CALIFORNIA STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

September 14, 2004

PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: San Diego Unified School District and California State Department of Education Child Development Division

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: Ratification of Agreement (Contract GPRE-4319) and Adoption of Resolution are to provide funding for 41 State Preschool sites. The district shall be reimbursed at a rate not to exceed \$16.59 per child per day of full-time enrollment.

TERM: July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005

AMOUNT OF FUNDING: \$5,971,653

SOURCE OF FUNDING: California State Department of Education Child Development Division

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The State Preschool Program is an ongoing program fully subsidized by the State Department of Education. The main objective is to provide a comprehensive development experience with special emphasis on preparation for kindergarten. The California State Department of Education recently approved the budget for 2004-2005.

Rationale for Ratification: This contract was received during the transition period of clerical and administrative support changes preventing a timely return of the signed contract.
