

EXPLANATION OF RATIFICATION OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN

Behavior & Educational Support Team (B.E.S.T.)

PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: San Diego Unified School District and Behavior & Educational Support Team (B.E.S.T.)

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: San Diego Unified School District contracts with nonpublic, nonsectarian schools or agencies to provide special education and/or related services to students with special needs.

TERM: July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005

AMOUNT OF FUNDING: \$250,000

SOURCE OF FUNDING: 5570 65000 00 5137 1180 5750 01000 4697
(Special Ed. Programs/Regular Year)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Under federal and state laws and regulations, pupils with disabilities ages 3 through 21 must be provided appropriate educational programs. If these programs are not available in a public school setting, then an alternative would be a nonpublic, nonsectarian school/agency placement to meet the requirements of the Individualized Education Program. The agreement being submitted for board approval would assure providing special education and/or related services through a nonpublic, nonsectarian school/agency to individuals with exceptional needs.
Rationale for Ratification: The NPS/NPA Schedule of Approved Fees was distributed to the District in late June. After preparing the master contract and obtaining signatures, September 14 is the first available board date.
