

EXPLANATION OF RATIFICATION OF AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT  
AND  
THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA ON BEHALF OF THE  
UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT SAN DIEGO

**PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT:** San Diego Unified School District and the Regents of the University of California on behalf of the University of California at San Diego

**AGREEMENT SUMMARY:** The District will provide seventeen buses for Preuss Charter School to transport Preuss students to and from school and to school activities.

**TERM:** August 15, 2004 through July 1430, 2005

**AMOUNT OF FUNDING:** Preuss will pay the District \$20,055 for each bus for a total of \$340,935

**SOURCE OF FUNDING:** Payment from Preuss shall be provided pursuant to invoices provided by the district.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** In prior years, transportation costs for Preuss students were covered by funds from the Targeted Instructional Improvement Grant program. With the determination by the State that charter schools could no longer participate in TIIG, transportation costs previously offset by TIIG at Preuss are paid for from the school's operational budget. As Preuss has changed from an "arm of the district" school to 501-c-3 status, the legal entity authorized to contract with the District is now clarified and details regarding service and cost have been agreed to, and thus this contract is presented as a ratification.
