Recommendation(s):

The superintendent recommends the Board of Education approve the appointment of Frisco White to the Advisory Committee on Utilization of Excess School Property (ACUESP) for the term September 20, 2004 through December 2005.

Summary of Previous Board of Education Discussion and Action:

The district established ACUESP and appointed nine members to the committee on October 25, 1994. On October 8, 2002, three Board Trustee appointees were appointed to serve on ACUESP to replace committee members who had resigned. On December 10, 2002, Board Trustee de Beck's appointee was approved to serve on the committee. One of the Superintendent's appointees was approved at the December 10, 2002 board meeting, and one was approved at the June 24, 2003 meeting.

Summary of Key Issue(s):

ACUESP was established pursuant to Education Code Section 17388 to advise the Board of Education in the development of districtwide policies and procedures governing the use or disposition of facilities and prior to the sale, lease, or rental of any excess real property. Education Code Section 17389 provides that ACUESP shall consist of not less than seven or more than eleven members.

Leon Brooks, who has served as an ACUESP member since the committee's inception in 1994 and served for many years on the district's Advisory Committee on Utilization of School Facilities, has resigned as the Superintendent's appointee to ACUESP in order to serve on the Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee (ICOC). Frisco White is the Superintendent's appointee to replace Mr. Brooks. Mr. White is an architect and Design Principal of Westberg + White, Inc., an architectural and planning firm. A community activist, Mr. White served as a Commissioner on the San Diego City Planning Commission from 1993 to 2000. He has been a Mentor at Morse and Lincoln high schools and been involved in various education organizations in the district.
