PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: San Diego Unified School District and County of San Diego

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: This contract provides for the co-funding of a school-based self-sufficiency program by the San Diego Unified School District and the County of San Diego through Social Advocates for Youth to provide support services to O'Farrell students, families, and community.

TERM: September 1, 2004 to August 31, 2005

AMOUNT OF FUNDING: \$86,529 from San Diego Unified School District

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: O'Farrell will co-fund the contract in collaboration with the San Diego County Health and Human Services Agency. Family Support Services would provide direct support to the educational families at O'Farrell and to students and parents. The Family Support Service Coordinator will also be the Community Agency Liaison and be responsible for assisting the homebase teachers with the coordination of the Community Service Program. This agreement renews an ongoing relationship between O'Farrell and the County of San Diego.
