### Recommendation(s):

### Summary of Previous Board of Education Discussion and Action:

On June 25, 2002, the board approved a Joint Powers Agreement to form the San Diego Model School Development Agency. On Nov. 12, 2002, the board also certified the Final Environmental Impact Report and selected the site for Florence Griffith-Joyner Elementary School, which serves as the anchor of the Model School project. At its Feb. 22, 2005, meeting, the board approved the construction contract for the school. In addition, the Board of Education periodically approves nominees for the San Diego Model School Development Agency Board of Directors.

### Summary of Key Issue(s):

This presentation is a summary of the San Diego Model School Development Agency project, which is an unprecedented and collaborative effort of four local agencies—SDCS, the City of San Diego and the city’s Housing Authority and Redevelopment Agency—to develop an urban village in the City Heights neighborhood. The intent is to periodically provide the Board of Education with an updated status report on this project.

### Fiscal Analysis:

Estimated costs are identified in the presentation. Proceeds of Proposition MM will fund the district’s portion of the project, but will not exceed what would be spent on a stand-alone school.
