PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: San Diego Unified School District and San Diego State University

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: Ratification of contract between San Diego Unified School District and San Diego State University Research Foundation to provide AB466 training as part of the District's overall plan to support the mathematics components of CORE Instructional Improvement; and provide a highly effective teacher in every classroom.

TERM: July 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Consultant agrees to provide of AB466 oversight as part of the District's plan to provide a highly effective teacher in every classroom. The training is professional development in mathematics content and pedagogy. It helps teachers build the expertise needed to effectively teach mathematics, using the State approved Harcourt Mathematics and Prentice Hall Mathematics curricula.

RATIONALE FOR JUSTIFICATION: Data was not readily available to estimate an acceptable number of teachers being trained or an approximate amount to be billed due to changes in personnel.

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
