

EXPLANATION OF RATIFICATION OF AGREEMENT

PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: San Diego Unified School District and the San Diego County Superintendent of Schools/Office of Education

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: The San Diego County Office of Education (SDCOE) shall provide After School Education and Safety Program (ASESP) grant funds to the District to operate San Diego's "6 to 6" Programs at Cohort 3 schools during the 2005-2006 school year.

TERM: July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006

AMOUNT OF FUNDING: \$1,683,704 from the SDCOE to the District

SOURCE OF FUNDING: ASESP grant funds, Cohort 3 recertification, CDE Grant No. 37-2002-391, District Budget No.5539 60100 00 5801 2100 1110 01000 0000

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The ASESP grant provides funds for San Diego's "6 to 6" Extended School Day Programs at specific elementary and middle school sites. The programs offer students in kindergarten through grade nine an opportunity to participate in academic and enrichment activities during before- and after-school hours when many parents are at work. This will be the seventh year that the SDCOE has provided funds to support this program.

This grant will fund San Diego's "6 to 6" Extended School Day Programs at the following 17 schools: Barnard Elementary, Birney Elementary, CPMA, Fulton Elementary, Hardy Elementary, Holly Drive Academy, Johnson Elementary, High Tech Middle, Language Academy, McGill Charter, McKinley Elementary, Museum School, Rowan Elementary, Sojourner Truth Academy, Tubman Village, Washington Elementary, and Wegeforth Elementary.

Rationale for Ratification: The District received the contract documents from the SDCOE on July 19, 2005 (after the July 1, 2005 start date).
