

EXPLANATION OF RATIFICATION OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SAN DIEGO STATE UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION
AND
SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

August 9, 2005

PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: San Diego Unified School District and San Diego State University Research Foundation (SDSU Research Foundation).

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: SDSU Research Foundation and the District's Mathematics Department, will continue to work together to provide practicing middle school teachers in eight selected middle schools (Gompers, Keiller, Kroc, Mann, Montgomery, Pacific Beach, Roosevelt, and Wilson) with experiences in the form of coursework and on-site coaching that will help them to develop a profound understanding of key mathematics concepts and develop effective mathematics instructional practice.

TERM: January 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006 (Project Term)

AMOUNT OF FUNDING: \$108,080 (funds to be paid to district)

SOURCE OF FUNDING: California Postsecondary Education Commission (CPEC) funds to be paid to SDCS, as the subawardee, by the SDSU Research Foundation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: San Diego State University Research Foundation (SDSU) and the district submitted a grant proposal to CPEC. The grant was awarded to SDSU with a subaward to the district of approximately 50 percent of the total award. The district's share is \$108,080. SDSU has received an award from the California Postsecondary Education Commission for project entitled "Collaborating to Learn Mathematics and Improve Practice." These funds are federal pass-through funds from the Office of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Education, CFDA no. 84-367.

REASON FOR RATIFICATION: The district just recently received notification of the subaward from San Diego State University Research Foundation
