Establishing a Separate Fund ) RESOLUTION  
In the San Diego County Treasury)

WHEREAS, Education Code section 47630 et seq. establishes a method for the funding of charter schools; and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 47651(a) provides that a charter school funded pursuant to Education Code 47630 et. seq. may receive the state aid portion of the charter school's total general purpose entitlement and categorical block grant directly, or through the local educational agency that granted its charter; and

WHEREAS, the following charter school which has been granted a charter by the San Diego Unified School District was previously not funded pursuant to Section 47630, but has now elected to be funded pursuant to section 47630: High Tech High K-8 Quarry Falls Charter School; and

WHEREAS, the above-enumerated charter school has now elected to directly receive the state aid portion of the charter school's total general purpose entitlement and categorical grant; and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 47651 (a) (1) further provides that in the case of a charter school that elects to receive its funding directly, a warrant shall be drawn in favor of the superintendent of schools of the county in which the local educational agency that approved the charter is located for deposit to the appropriate funds or accounts of the charter school in the county treasury; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish separate accounts with the San Diego Treasurer for each of said charter school; and

WHEREAS, in order to establish such separate account the San Diego County Treasurer requires a resolution by the Board of Education approving the establishment of such separate accounts for the said charter school.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a separate fund shall be established in the San Diego County treasury for funds received by the San Diego Unified School District for High Tech High K-8 Quarry Falls Charter School; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said separate charter school fund shall receive income from property tax transfers, state apportionments made pursuant to Education Code section 47630 et seq., lottery funding, and other state and federal categorical funding to which the charter schools may be entitled; and all such funds shall be expended for the purpose of charter school operations.
