RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 910.8 of the Government Code authorizes the Board of Education to delegate to an employee the function of determining that a claim is insufficient because the claim fails to comply substantially with the requirements of Government Code Sections 910 and 910.2, or with the requirements of a form provided under Section 910.4 if such claim is presented pursuant thereto; and

WHEREAS Section 911.3 of the Government Code authorizes the Board of Education to delegate to an employee the functions of determining and giving notice that a claim is not timely presented and that the claim is being returned without action; and

WHEREAS Sections 906 et seq. and 935.4 of the Government Code authorizes the Board of Education to delegate to an employee the functions of rejecting a claim, allowing or settling a claim within monetary limits prescribed by the Board of Education, rejecting or allowing an application for leave to present a late claim, and the giving of written notice of such actions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education desires to delegate its authority as specified above to the Office of General Counsel;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the authority to determine the sufficiency or lack of timeliness of a claim, to reject or grant a claim within the monetary limit authorized by the Board of Education, to reject or allow an application for leave to present a late claim, and to give written notice of such actions is hereby delegated to the Office of General Counsel.
