## Description

Fred Baker Elementary is located in the Mountain View community. The majority of our students live in the neighborhood. We are fortunate to have San Diego Park across the street.

Students benefit from a comprehensive core curriculum of literacy, mathematics, science, social studies and physical education. We offer weekly enrichment, adding technology, dance and chorus classes. The Bobcat News program highlights our many school events in a weekly live broadcast.

Our character education program utilizes the foundational blocks from the book *Inch and Miles* by John Wooten. Recognition assemblies are held every five weeks for outstanding efforts. The monthly *Inch and Miles* drawing gives students the opportunity to lunch with the principal. Awards of special dog tags for attendance, uniforms, and other achievements are given throughout the year.

Teacher professional development and grade-level collaboration focuses on student achievement. We provide small group teacher support and push-in teachers for students at risk of not reaching proficiency.

Relationships with parents, the business community and public stakeholders are significant. We invite involvement through principal's chats, family Fridays, family literacy and math activities, and dad's club. Teachers go the extra mile, making home visits to provide progress reports and supportive information on how parents can support their child's learning at home. We solicit community members' participation as volunteers, and on decision-making committees.

We are proud of our steady progress. We believe collaboration, and high expectations of our students, are the key to our success in making gains and improving Baker's student performance.
