Description

Cadman Elementary is a small school environment in north Clairemont. We provide an excellent setting for identifying and supporting children’s academic and social needs. Many wonderful children come to our school through VEEP, Choice and our special education program.

Staff takes pride in providing a rigorous, standards-based curriculum while recognizing students’ individual needs. Direct support will be provided to at-risk and EL students through state and federal funds. K-2 teachers trained in theater, visual arts and dance provide an enriched visual and performing arts curriculum in their classrooms. A certificated staff member teaches weekly dance class. Grades 3 through 5 receive weekly instruction in band, orchestra or choir. We hold two dance performances a year.

We maintain close relationships with students, parents, staff and community as we work together to improve academic achievement.

Collaborative relationships with Clairemont High School, UCSD and CSUSM provide instructional support, tutoring and mentoring for our students.

Our active PTA sponsors numerous activities providing fun ways to spend quality time with our students and families. For example we hold family reading night/pajama party and movie night. Volunteers serve as tutors, speakers, mentors and chaperones. The principal holds informal opportunities to discuss school issues at monthly Java with Jackie meetings.

Cadman enjoys partnerships with the Senior Baseball League, La Jolla YMCA, Jamba Juice, Mission Federal Credit Union and Hometown Buffet. Many parents take advantage of before- and after school childcare provided by Harmonium. The La Jolla YMCA provides after-school sports activities on our minimum day afternoons.
