## Description

Edison Elementary is located in City Heights. Our slogan is "A school for high achievers." Our staff, students, and parents work together to significantly increase the number of students who improve their academic achievement on state tests.

Our teachers are well trained in literacy and mathematics frameworks. English language development is offered at all grade levels to support English learners in the classrooms. We continue to provide additional academic support for students through our extended-day reading, literacy support teachers and computer lab. We are proud to have two preschool classes that consist of two sessions each. These classes help prepare students for academic and social success in kindergarten. Music is available for all students. All 5th graders receive instrumental music once a week.

We were awarded the QEIA grant to support student achievement. The Aspire program provides individual and group counseling. The 2nd Steps program helps teachers demonstrate positive choices for students. Rainbow Counseling assists individuals and families with coping during times of adjustment and emotional difficulty. We recently launched the Positive Behavior Intervention Support program to reduce behavior difficulties.

We work together with parents to plan interventions that build on students' strengths and support their specific areas of need. Our PrimeTime program, provided by Harmonium, gives working families the opportunity to have their students receive extra literacy instruction, homework assistance, and time for supervised play.
