Description

Horton Elementary sits on a hill in the Mountain View neighborhood, above Market Street, near the Euclid trolley stop. Built in 1958, we have newly renovated landscaping and playground features. We are near the Malcolm X Public Library, the Science Center and Market Creek Shopping Center.

Horton's attendance boundary consists of apartment buildings, duplexes, and single-family dwellings. We receive Title 1 funding. All our students receive free/reduced lunch.

We respect the diversity, language, culture, and gender of all our students, families and community. Our newer and experienced teachers have expertise working with diverse cultures.

Horton Elementary students become self-motivated, lifelong learners prepared to participate productively within a democratic

society. We believe parents and teachers must work together to achieve these lifelong goals.

Our students' educational interests, physical and mental health, are our top priority. We share a "friendship salad" where everyone brings a fruit to a classroom celebration. Horton students took part in an exercise video, aired at every Padres Sunday family day game, to encourage active play of parents and children. Over 900 Horton students and family members attended Sunday home games gratis this past season!!

We operate a SBCP to ensure that all students are provided an enriched instructional program. Our goal is to raise the academic achievement of every single student at Horton. We expect this improvement to be reflected in better attendance and increased CST scores. We invite our entire school community: parents, children, school staff, and partners to join us in this work.
