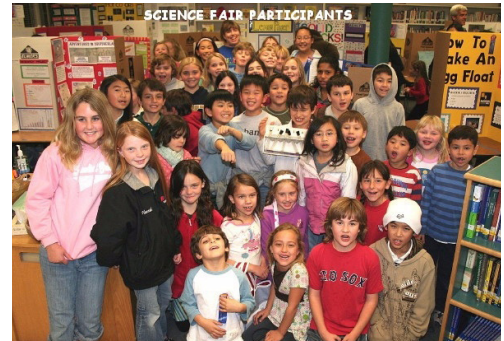

## Description

Kumeyaay Elementary, opened in 1994, is located in the northern part of Tierrasanta. This "Island in the Hills" community is composed of middle-income single-family homes, townhouses, and apartments. Tierrasanta has a large number of military families, and one of the largest Navy housing complexes in Southern California.

Our students speak 22 languages. Over 58 percent of our children are local, more than 13 percent participate in VEEP and Special Education. Kumeyaay receives hundreds of applications annually through CHOICE.

Strong parent involvement results in over 2,000 annual volunteer hours. Our PTA and Foundation provide support for an enriched arts and science academic program and educational technology tools.

Teachers instruct hands-on science lab and music enrichment program. We offer a weekly

science club. A 5th grade team attends the yearly county Science Field Day. Last year we began our own annual science fair for all grades.

Parents train with a professional artist to teach standards-based art lessons. Lessons reflect a multitude of styles, from Picasso to Monet. The 5th grade created a mural based on the work of artist David Hockney. The mural was displayed at San Diego International Airport.

The Kumeyaay Code teaches the character traits of responsibility, trustworthiness, caring, respect, fairness, and citizenship. Students display these qualities as a Kumeyaay Ambassador each morning, or Kindergarten Buddy at lunchtime. Students, parents and staff provide necessities to victims of recent fires, annual teddy bear drive for the Children's Hospital, and clothing drive for students at our sister school, Adams Elementary.
