Description

Doris Miller Elementary School is located in the Tierrasanta/Murphy Canyon area. Miller was named after an African-American war hero. Petty Officer Doris Miller served aboard the USS West Virginia during Pearl Harbor. He earned the Navy Cross for assisting his mortally wounded commanding officer to safety from the bridge. Miller then manned a machine gun, successfully firing on attacking Japanese enemy aircraft. He was posthumously awarded the Purple Heart in 1943.

Our school has a culturally diverse student population. Most students live in surrounding military housing. Others enroll through Choice and Special Education programs. All of our school's stakeholders honor and follow the Miller Way: everyone should be responsible, respectful and caring.

Miller's biggest challenge is the high mobility of students in military families. Our goal is to ensure that students new to the school quickly acquire necessary skills. We place great emphasis on helping all students become proficient readers, writers, listeners, speakers and mathematicians. Students are encouraged to read and write at home regularly.

We invite parents and community partners to become members of Miller's learning community through volunteering in the classroom and at activities.

Administrators and teachers are involved in the development, coordination and presentation of staff development and grade-level planning meetings. Miller teachers continually receive intense training in literacy, writing and mathematics. They also participate in diverse conferences.
