Description

Rolando Park Elementary is a quaint, beautiful school that was built in 1951 as part of the La Mesa-Spring Valley School District. With boundary changes, we became part of the San Diego Unified School District. Our school is nestled in a residential neighborhood with a preponderance of single-family homes. We are located just north of the 94 Highway and east of College Avenue.

We offer a curriculum aligned with state standards, focused on literacy, mathematics and systematic ELD. Rolando Park programs include Special Education, Pre-K, extended day reading and math, before and after school and academic enrichment programs. Students can participate in student council.

Parents are encouraged to become involved at the school. Parents comprise half the

membership of the SSC and Site Governance Team. Our active parents serve as school volunteers and participate in ELAC. Events such as Muffins with Mom and Donuts with Dads are meaningful activities for all involved. Weekly English classes for parents are held on site.

Business community partners include The Salvation Army’s Ray and Joan Kroc Community Center, Washington Mutual Bank, Albertson’s Grocery Store, Coco’s Restaurant, Sam’s Club, and The Laubach Literacy Council. The California school garden grant enabled students to create and maintain two gardens on our campus.

Rolando Park students are recognized for participating in the longest established annual Martin Luther King Jr. Day parade in the City of San Diego, hosted by Knox Elementary School.
