Description

Herbert Hoover is the home of famed baseball slugger Ted Williams, who grew up in the area and played ball at Hoover before progressing to a Hall of Fame career in the big leagues. With a majority of Hispanic students, our school is rich in cultural diversity. This composition provides students with opportunities to develop the skills needed for racial harmony and understanding.

Hoover's student body consists of approximately 40 percent English Learners. About two-thirds of students come from homes where a language other than English is spoken.

In 1998, we embarked on a process to study student data to evaluate areas that needed improvement and to identify students who were not achieving academic success. Through this process, we began to focus on literacy development. The Collaborative (see below) and

SDSU have offered course work and visiting professor assistance. Our teachers are trained in techniques to assist English Learners and in research-based instructional practices. As a result, reading and mathematics scores have increased across all grade levels and student subsets.

We are involved in the City Heights Educational Collaborative: a partnership with Clark Middle School, Rosa Parks Elementary School, San Diego State University and the Price Foundation. The Collaborative's objectives are to improve student achievement and to create a K-16 learning environment that provides enhanced post-secondary opportunities.

Hoover has received a six-year Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) accreditation.
