Description

La Jolla High School, which opened in 1922, is one of the District’s oldest facilities. Its 12-acre site west of I-5 delineates the District’s western boundary.

Although LHS is located in a high socioeconomic area, more than one-quarter of students are non-residential. Some 13 percent are inner city students who participate in VEEP. Approximately 17 percent are enrolled through the Choice or NCLB program.

LHS’s mission is to provide opportunities and equal access to a rigorous curriculum so that all students might achieve at a high level of proficiency. Our vision is to prepare students to become contributing members of a competitive and technological society.

Efforts have paid off. In 2003, we were recognized as a California Distinguished School and named as a California AVID School of Distinction for San Diego County for attaining the highest overall performance for three consecutive years.

Other honors have followed; currently LHS is the only public high school west of the Mississippi to have a chapter in the Cum Laude Society. Washington Post education writer Jay Matthews, praised LHS in his book, *Class Struggle*, saying, “La Jolla High School seemed to have achieved all that an American public school could hope for.”

National Merit Finalists numbered 15 in 2006-07 and 16 in 2007-08. Our 44 athletic teams secure CIF titles each year in one or more sports in which students participate.
