Description

Morse High School is located on a beautiful 65-acre site in Southeast San Diego. The distinguished murals adorning our buildings express the diversity and pride of our students. This pride is evident in the academic programs as well. Advanced computer, athletic and technology programs, math and science curriculum and the aeronautics courses make Morse one of a kind.

Students come from the surrounding community. Our population is culturally diverse. 14 percent are English learners, speaking 11 languages. 24 percent of our students are enrolled in GATE and Seminar, 12 percent are enrolled in special education.

We focus on increasing student achievement by examining teacher practice and refining the alignment of curriculum to state standards.

Teachers in all content areas seek to improve instruction by examining student achievement data and sharing their practices. We look at ways to make the curriculum more relevant to students' lives to better prepare them for the demands of the world.

Our school was built in 1962. Proposition MM in 1998 financed the expansion of the science buildings, a new library, and a new two-story classroom. The recent passage of Proposition S will fund the following new facilities: culinary arts building, an auto body facility, child development center, stadium bleacher renovation/addition with new synthetic turf and track, a lunch shelter and kiosks, a classroom building to replace bungalow classrooms, the renovation of gymnasium and locker rooms, and a new cover for the outdoor amphitheater.
