Description

The School of Community Health and Medical Practices (CHAMPS) is centrally located in City Heights on the Crawford Educational Complex campus. The high school complex, built in 1957, was converted in 2004 into four autonomous, career theme high schools.

Our students are culturally diverse. Many speak English as a second language. We foster a culture of excellence, bringing students one step closer to success in continuing education and future careers. Our rigorous college preparatory curriculum integrates health and medical themes throughout courses.

To prepare our students for college we practice commitment, leadership, and community. Our college-going culture is supported through school-wide AVID. Students become advocates for their own futures by enrolling in AVID and the numerous AP classes offered. All juniors are taking the SAT Reasoning Test in 2009.

We take pride in offering a more personalized education in health and medical science. Students can learn how to make a difference in the medical field of their choice. Additionally, our advisory program helps students in achieving both present and future goals.
