

Sock Sort Concentration

Module 1-Getting ready for Kindergarten Sorting and Classifying

Your child is learning to sort and classify. Knowing ways to identify things that are alike and not alike can help children sort and classify objects. Use this activity to help your child practice identifying things that are alike and not alike.

Materials:

- Sock Sort Cards

Directions:

1. Cut out the Sock Sort cards.
2. Shuffle the cards and place the cards face down in rows.
3. Players take turns turning over 2 cards looking for a match.
4. If the cards match exactly, the player keeps both cards and takes another turn.
5. If the cards do not match, player must tell how they are different and turn them back over.
6. Continue until all the cards are matched.
7. The player with the most cards is the winner.

Questions to ask your child while playing:

- If socks match,
 1. How are the socks the same or alike? (e.g., same size, same pattern)
- If socks do not match,
 1. How are the socks different or not alike?
 2. Is there any way the socks are the same? (e.g., same size but different pattern)
