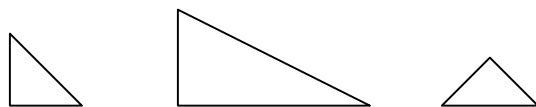


# Rocket Race to Space

## Module 6-Geometry and Equal Parts

Your child is learning about geometry. He or she is learning to recognize and name geometric shapes. Shapes can have different sizes and be in different positions. For example:



Use this activity to help your child learn to recognize shapes in different positions.

### Materials:

- Rocket Race to Space Gameboard
- Shape Cards
- Game Pieces (ex: coins, buttons, Cheerios, paper clips, beans)

### Directions:

1. Cut out the shape cards.
2. Shuffle the cards and place them face down in a pile.
3. Each player will need a game piece. Place the pieces at the Start.
4. Player 1 picks a card and moves his or her game piece ahead to that shape, and then places the card at the bottom of the pile.
5. Players take turns.
6. The player who gets to the Finish first wins.

### Questions to ask your child while playing:

- What do we call this shape?
- What everyday object has this same shape?
