

# Reach for a Ribbon Game

## Module 9-Measurement

Your child is learning about measurement. He or she is learning how long and how tall objects are. Use this activity to help your child compare lengths. In addition, you might point out two or more items at home and encourage your child to compare lengths.

### **Materials:**

- Ribbon Cards
- Paper Bag

### **Directions:**

1. Cut out the ribbons and place them in a paper bag.
2. Each player reaches into the bag without looking and takes a ribbon.
3. Players compare their ribbons. The one who has the longest ribbon keeps both.
4. Play until all the ribbons have been picked.
5. Then count the ribbons. The player with the most ribbons wins.
6. Play again. This time the player with the shorter ribbon keeps the ribbons.

### **Questions to ask your child while playing:**

- Which ribbon is longer?
- Which ribbon is shorter?
