- High expectations for self and others

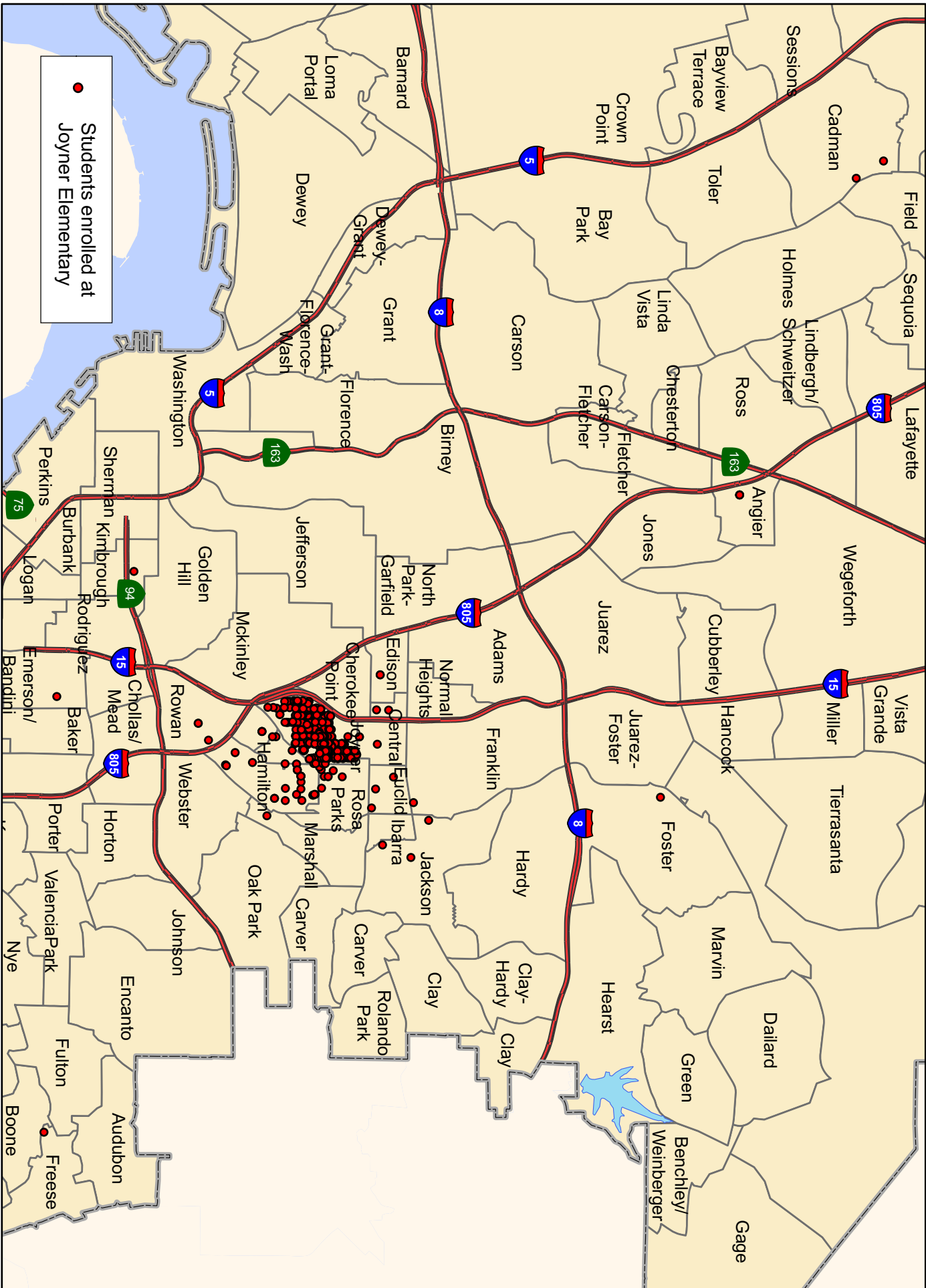
Our commitment to physical education seeks to foster in students an understanding and application of what it means to live a healthy lifestyle through nutrition, health and physical fitness.
