"Think globally, learn locally"

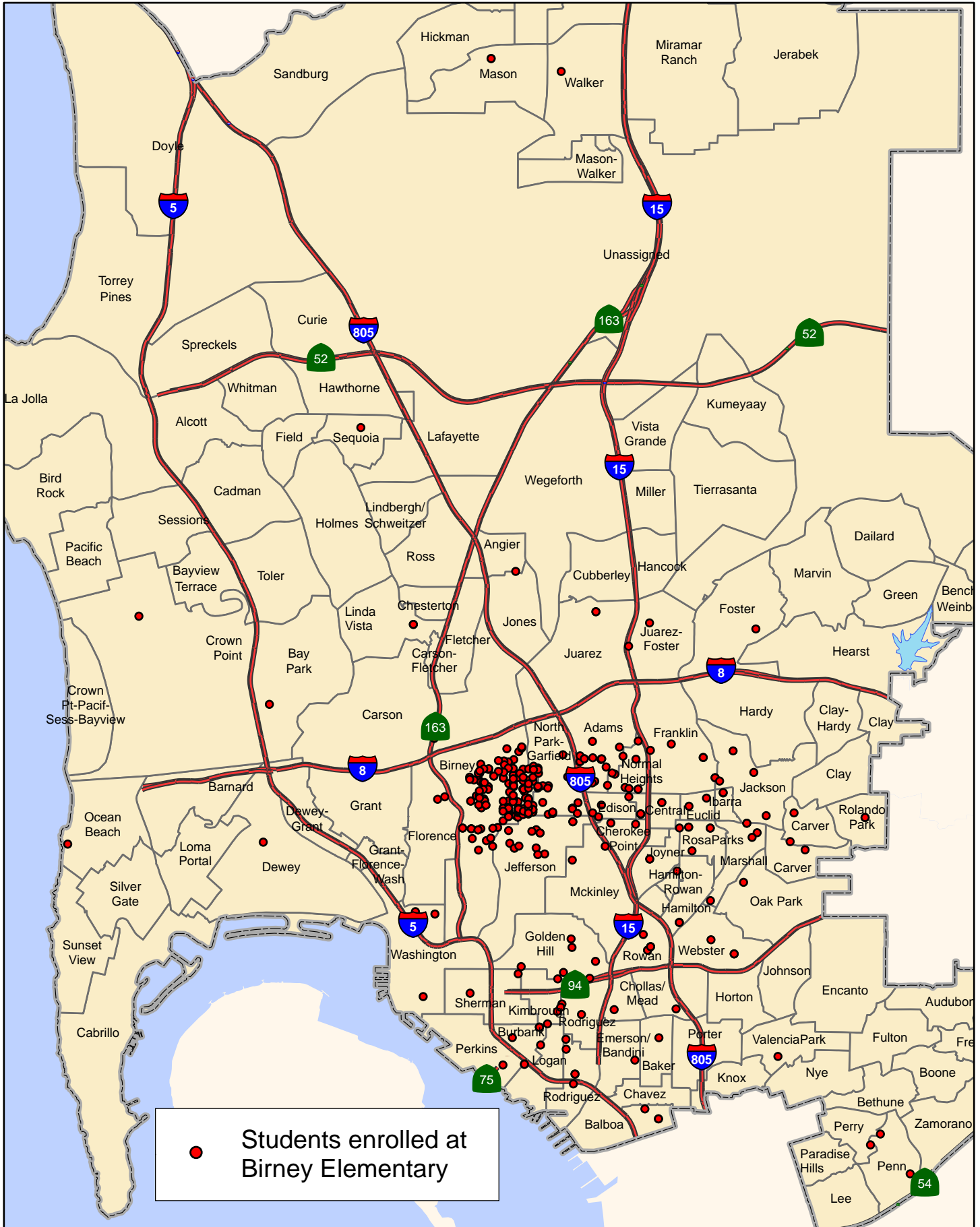
