• SMART Goals:

English/Language Arts SMART Goal:

By the end of June 2009, 60 % of students (209 students) in 2-6 will receive a score of proficient as measured on the district-developed writing rubrics in the area of Ideas/Content and Organization.

By the end of June 2009, 60% (40 students) will score proficient or higher on the state writing assessment.

Closing the Gap SMART Goal:

By the end of June 2009, 50 % (87 students) of English Learners will progress a level or higher in all areas of writing as measured on the English Language Development Performance Indicator.

Mathematics SMART Goal:

By June 2009, an increase from 70% to 78% of students (272students) in grades 2-6 will score proficient or advanced in the Number Sense Strand using district benchmark assessments and end of module assessments.

Closing the Gap SMART Goal:

By June 2009, an increase from 73 % to 78% of our English Learners in grades 2-6 (total of 135 students) will score proficient or advanced in conceptual understanding of number sense on the end of module and benchmark assessments.
