



2009-2010 Middle School Participation

San Diego Unified School District's Extended Learning Opportunities Department (ELO) administers the PrimeTime Extended Day Program (PrimeTime) offering before and/or after school programs to elementary and middle school aged students. PrimeTime is free to all participating families and operates before and/or after school every regular school day. Parents/guardians can feel comfortable knowing their child(ren) is not only receiving academic support, but also interacting with peers in a physically and emotionally safe environment. The PrimeTime team is a collaboration among ELO staff, PrimeTime Partner organizations, departments, programs and individuals who work together to make PrimeTime the best it can be. PrimeTime maintains a student to staff ratio of 20 to 1 at the middle level.

ELIGIBILITY

Middle school students interested in participating in PrimeTime at the schools listed below are eligible to participate as long as they are enrolled at the school they are applying for during the regular school day.

PROCESS FOR ENROLLMENT

Families with children enrolled at the middle schools listed below are not required to fill out a PrimeTime Application in order for their child(ren) to participate. Middle school students interested in participating in PrimeTime will be accepted. The 2009-2010 PrimeTime Student Participation Forms are required to be filled out and submitted to the Partner organization providing services at your child(ren)'s school before your child(ren) can begin attending. Middle school participation dates may vary based upon staffing availability to meet state required staffing ratios. It is highly recommended you submit your child(ren)'s PrimeTime Student Participation Forms between June 1, 2009, and the end of the 2008-2009 school year in order to identify sufficient staff for the first day of school.

The 2009-2010 PrimeTime Student Participation Forms should be turned into the PrimeTime staff at your child(ren)'s school or mailed to the Partner organization providing services. Student Participation Forms will be available at your child(ren)'s school in English and Spanish beginning on June 1, 2009, and on the District's website at www.sandi.net on July 2, 2009. The 2009-2010 Student Participation Forms must be completed in order for your child(ren) to begin attending.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

In accordance with the California Education Code, students are expected to attend the program everyday for the full range of hours offered. Students who do not attend regularly may be subject to disenrollment.
