Approval of the minutes moved by Dawna Hermanson, seconded by Michelle Hackley. Motion passed 10-0. • By-laws addition of Section A, Vice Chair Position. Revision to add position for Vice Chair to fulfill duties of President in their absence. Michelle Hackley voted in as Chair person. Laura K. motions for approval of new person, Annette F. seconds. Motion passed 10-0.

SPSA <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Technology ➤ Teacher Support ➤ Combination of the Two (2) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Action Item: Mr. Dale, Principal 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Annette reports K-3 wants technology, K-2 Voyager program. Not too familiar with Joy Cowley, but interested in reading program. Wants to see demo. Michelle H. 4th-5th split on push-in and technology. Person would run Voyager program with kids. Dawna H. and Heather W. reports that parents interested in Technology versus a person due to unsuccessful pull-out from last year, concerns about more turn-around, technology showing of the times to come. Ky S. has input regarding a technology lab, to utilize the library more. He found info that shows kids learn more from going to a computer lab versus rotating around 4 class computers. This new 'Learning Center' could be unique and be a continual place to grow, an investment that pays. • Mr. Dale states that it is State mandated that children identified as ELD/ESL are required to have a 30minute reading group in a small setting. Voyager program would benefit these kids. • Teacher support was not supported by teachers or parents. Too expensive. <p>Costs as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Substitute person \$800/mo. \$100 per day • Voyager Program for 2-5th Grade \$15,000. \$2,000 for instructional supplies. \$13,000 for salary. • Push-in person support \$125 Four (4) times a week (Mon/Tues/Th/Fri) for four (4) hours. • K-1st Grade Award Reading (Joy Cowley) \$10,000. • Accelerated Reading/Math program for K-5 \$5,000 • Remaining balance roughly \$13,000 to purchase computers (8 at approx. \$1,500 each). 25 new desktop MacIntosh computers were purchased last year for Grades 2-3. • Motion made by Laura K. that we allocate the 2007-2008 remaining funds be used to purchase Voyager for 2-5, with teacher support. K-1 Award Reading/Joy Cowley and Accelerator Reader/Math for K-5 with remaining \$13,000 to be applied towards technology support (ie: computers). Dawna H. seconds, motion passed 10-0.
