Welcome to the San Diego High Educational Complex, which offers all students a rigorous college preparatory curriculum in a personalized learning environment. Each of the six San Diego schools is an independent community that offers students the opportunity to select a theme that matches their interests and allows them to make real world connections.

LEADS High School

Lead, Explore, Achieve, Discover and Serve as you learn through school and community projects and develop real world connections through internships and career explorations. LEADS students will benefit from time spent in the community as well as the classroom, learning leadership skills and gaining work experience.

Electives may include: American Sign Language, Developmental Psychology of Children, Nutrition and Fitness, and Military and Protective Services.

School of International Studies

Explore Internationalism at the School of International Studies by visiting, hosting and developing friendships with students from schools in Russia, Argentina and Austria. All courses have a global focus and the school also features the prestigious *International Baccalaureate (IB)* program which offers rigorous academic preparation and the possibility of earning college credit and an international diploma.

Electives may include: International Trade Careers; IB Film Studies, Drama and Art; and Theory of Knowledge.



School of Business

Prepare for a career in a business-related field by studying at the School of Business. Students can explore business topics such as finance or travel and tourism while gaining an opportunity to engage in internships and take supplemental business courses at area community colleges.

Electives may include: Business and Financial Markets, Accounting, Macro Economics, Culinary Arts, Introduction to Travel and Tourism, and Business Management and Ownership.

School of Science and Technology

Students at the School of Science and Technology will use computer technology and explore the many uses of science and technology while gaining exposure to a variety of careers in both fields through job shadows and internships.



Electives may include: Environmental and Spatial Technology (EAST), SciTech, Business and Computer Applications (BACA), Web Design and Auto Shop.

School of Media, Visual and Performing Arts

Balance artistic development with academic preparation at the School of Media, Visual and Performing Arts. Students will have the opportunity to study arts such as vocal and instrumental music, dance, illustration, television production and theatre studies while preparing for college or careers.

Electives may include: Jazz Dance, Music Theory, Playwriting, Art History and Acting.

School of Communication Investigations in a Multicultural Atmosphere (CIMA)

CIMA offers students the opportunity to enhance their language skills while learning about multiculturalism and career options in the communications field. Through CIMA students can take a variety of bilingual courses and explore ideas through interdisciplinary and theme-based projects.

Electives may include: Bilingual courses in math, science and social studies, Computer Applications, Business Environments and Contemporary Communication.

The San Diego High Educational Complex offers students the opportunity to become involved in a variety of sports and clubs as well as explore careers through internships, job shadows and mentorships. The three magnet programs – International Baccalaureate, Language Immersion and the Writing Academy – will continue and are infused in the appropriate school or across the entire complex.
