



## NCLB Programs

### Title V: Innovative Programs

Title V encourages education reform and innovative school improvement programs to improve school, student, and teacher performance. Private school students, teachers, and other educational personnel may receive professional development, library materials, and educational equipment.

#### **Identification of Students**

The primary assessment is library collection development done by the school library staff. In addition, equipment inventory for library and classroom is included in the library assessment.

On-site personnel must assess professional development, community service, and health service needs.

#### **District Services/Products**

The district will order, process and deliver (if appropriate) library materials and equipment. All other program services requested will be referred to an appropriate source provider.

#### **Timeline for Delivery of District Services/Products**

After a preliminary meeting, school assessments, library plans and orders are due mid-June. Delivery occurs during the summer and fall. Timelines have been structured to provide the materials for the coming school year. All other delivery of services will be determined by the specific source provider.

#### **Delivery Logistics of District Services/Products**

Library and equipment are delivered to the school, when appropriate. All other logistics are with the source provider.
