

INTENT TO DONATE

Your donated vehicle will be used in a variety of ways in this San Diego City Schools Transportation Technology Program (Auto Shop). All of these ways are designed to benefit district students and enhance their instruction. The following is a brief description of the options that may be exercised in dealing with your donated vehicle.

1. Initially, each vehicle will go through a safety inspection to discover the specific problems that exist and what might be involved in repairing them.
2. After evaluating what is wrong with the car, an estimate of the repairs is made to determine if repairing it is economically feasible.
3. The repair and disposition of the vehicle could involve one of the following alternatives:
 - a. Associated Student Body Auto Shop funds are used to purchase parts to repair the vehicle in order for it to be road ready. When it is safe and operational, the vehicle is sold to the highest bidder for the cost of the parts that were used.

The vehicle may be sold to a student, the general public, or a staff member but not necessarily in that order. All moneys received from the sale of a vehicle are placed back into the Associated Student Body Auto Shop account in order to purchase needed tools and supplies for the Magnet Program.

- b. Another alternative is to have an interested student adopt the car and have him/her use his/her own money to repair the vehicle until it reaches a road ready condition. When this point is achieved, the student has the option of purchasing the car for the price of the parts. Any amount acquired above this amount is placed into the Associated Student Body Auto Shop fund to be used for the purchase of school tools and supplies.
 - c. A third alternative would be to scrap the vehicle and salvage all usable parts for the repair of other student's vehicles. That part of the body of chassis, which is not used by the transportation technology or transportation technology body and spray classes, will be discarded.
