Community is invited to help design new elementary school

New school in Logan Heights will ease crowding at King, Logan and Perkins

SAN DIEGO – Plan to attend the Design Task Force community meetings for the new elementary school in Logan Heights, also known as the King/Logan/Perkins Area Elementary School:

Wednesday, April 30 – 6:30 - 8:30 p.m.

As a member of the Design Task Force, you'll have the opportunity to voice your ideas about the design of the new school. Residents, civic leaders, parents, school administrators and students are welcome to participate. Through the interactive "design charette" process, the architect will guide the Design Task Force to complete the overall design of the project during the working sessions.

About the new school: The new school will be bound by Martin Avenue on the north, the alley between Logan Avenue and Greely Avenue on the south, 32nd Street on the east, and 31st Street on the west, and excludes parcels in the northwest corner. The project will require the acquisition of about 15 dwelling units and relocation of 42 residents. About 4 acres of the 6.5-acre site is undeveloped district-owned property and doesn't require acquisition or relocation of residents. The project, which will cost about \$23.6 million, will be funded by Proposition MM, the \$1.51 billion bond that is funding modernization of 165 schools and construction of 16 new/rebuilt schools. Construction will begin in Spring 2005, and the new school is scheduled to open in Fall 2006.
