Clairemont High School to dedicate brand-new library building and amphitheater

Background: Clairemont High School has a brand-new library to house its expansive book collections and state-of-the-art computer lab. The new building replaces the old library, which was located in a classroom. An amphitheater/lunch court was also built next to the library.

The Clairemont High School project was funded by Proposition MM, a \$1.51 billion bond measure passed by San Diego voters in 1998. Other work at Clairemont included new science classrooms, painting, floor and ceiling repairs, carpeting, increased accessibility of the physically disabled, and other major renovations.

Proposition MM is funding modernization at 165 existing schools and construction of 16 new/rebuilt schools to support student achievement throughout the district.
