- * \$1287 per course; 20% discount for groups of 20+

A Master of Arts in Teaching with a Specialization in NBC Teacher Leadership is for:

- ANY teacher or counselor who wants to develop a portfolio reflecting the National Board Certified Teacher model as part of required course work for the Master of Arts in Teaching Degree (or administrative master's option)
- ANY teacher or counselor who wants to develop a portfolio before they go through the certification as a "dress rehearsal" in preparation for certification later.
- New NBCT candidates who want to earn a Master's while they develop the portfolio (each entry = content for one month course) and earn credit
- ANY Renewal or Advanced Candidates who need to develop portfolio entries
- ANY teacher or counselor who wants to improve they work they do with students as part of a meaningful master's degree program
