Elementary and secondary teachers seeking to gain expertise in the study of reading and language arts, including content area reading, will find that the SDSU program offers excellent opportunities both in research and in practical application. Graduates are prepared to assume leadership roles in the area of reading/language arts. Courses are taught in the late afternoon and early evening for educational professionals. Part time attendance leads to the degree and credential in about two and one half years.
