Performance details:

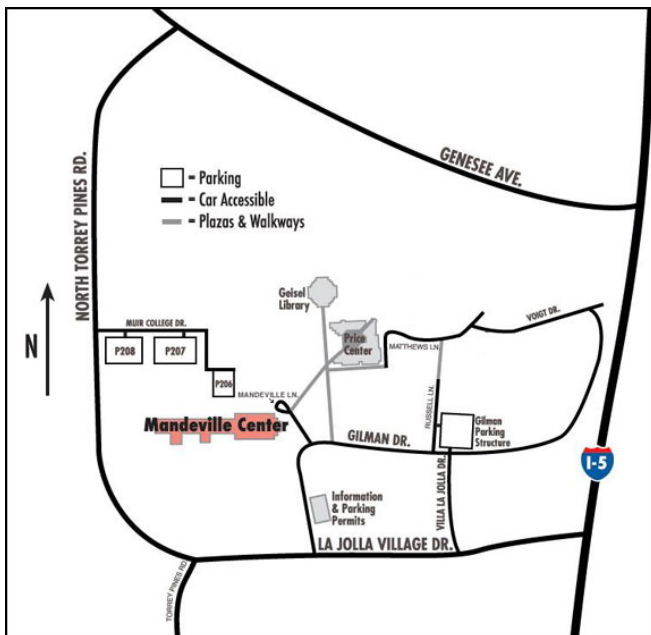
Beethoven, Higdon, Hindemith and Rachmaninoff!

Blue Cathedral – Jennifer Higdon’s ‘imaginary journey through a glass cathedral in the sky’ for flute, clarinet and orchestra.

Mathis der Maler – Paul Hindemith composes a masterpiece portraying the Renaissance painter, Mathias Grunewald.

Piano Concerto No. 1 – composed when he was 19 years old, Sergei Rachmaninoff creates a challenging piece for two hands!
