SUBJECT: ***STAR TEST BREAKFASTS***

During this year's upcoming STAR testing period, there is often an emphasis placed on ensuring that all students have a healthy breakfast. As you prepare, Food Services would like you to be aware that you have the following options.

Option #1

Continue the regular breakfast program at your school during STAR testing.
Works best: At schools where large numbers of students already eat breakfast.

Option #2

Move breakfast time from before school to a scheduled break on testing day, continue the regular breakfast menu.

Works best: At schools where few students eat breakfast before school and there is adequate time to serve the students.

Option #3

Move breakfast time from before school to a scheduled break on testing day, serve a special breakfast menu (attached).

Works best: At schools where few students eat breakfast before school and there is only a short break scheduled.

Regardless of which option is right for your school, Food Services is happy to announce that we can continue to serve all breakfasts **FREE OF CHARGE TO ALL STUDENTS** on any four days that you designate. Not having to collect money or PIN numbers will speed up your meal service so that students can get back to classes as quickly as possible.

Be sure not miss the upcoming deadlines of **March 30** for traditional schools and **May 2** for year-round schools in order to sign up for this opportunity.

1. Food Services will provide free breakfasts to all students during STAR testing only at the request of individual schools.
2. Breakfast can be served only once per day (can't serve breakfast before school and again later in the morning.)
3. Up to four days of free breakfasts to all students will be provided. Dates do not have to be consecutive.
4. Breakfasts must be served in the cafeteria, not individual classrooms.
5. In order to assure that enough food is available orders must be turned in on time. Requests received after the deadline may be subject to cancellation if food is not available.
