Are you interested in completing a MA degree but can't imagine how you can do it while you're teaching full time? The San Diego State University summer only (MA) Masters of Arts in Curriculum and Instruction with an emphasis on Literacy for teachers of grades K-12 is your answer. You can complete this program in three summers.

Here's how it works. Each summer you take 3 or 4 courses. One of the courses each summer is a literacy conference. All courses are very practical and are designed to meet the schedules of traditional and year round teachers because they are held in the late afternoons during the months of June and July. If you're just interested in the conference it may be taken as a separate 3 unit course. Don't worry if you're teaching year round the conference course can be completed via video.
