This course is designed for Primary grade teachers who want to be better teachers of young children by establishing a plan for providing identification and evaluation of young gifted children. You will learn mechanisms for differentiating instruction, including alternate options for students with unique needs. Teachers will begin with the differences of the child, adjust the lessons and curriculum accordingly. This course is open to all primary teachers who want to do a better job of teaching in order to influence all the years that follow and who have an adamant interest in developing potentially gifted students at an early age.

Creativity is the ability to generate relevant solutions to a pressing problem. Teachers will raise and discuss issues to assist students to look at problems in new and unusual ways, to generate a greater number of ideas, to challenge the existing ways of doing things and to be speculative, playful with thinking, and willing to take risks. Creating originality of thought with fresh approaches, ingenuity, and the ability to set aside established procedures will be some of the ideas discussed in this Seminar.

We will be removing the brakes that stop creativity by going beyond the first reaction and requiring students to become problem solvers rather than following their natural tendency to judge an idea as good or bad before truly evaluating it.

Learn ways to challenge gifted and advanced students to develop a deeper, more complex and extensive understanding of subject matter.
