PAR CONSULTING TEACHER**

The Peer Assistance and Review (PAR) Program is looking for district teachers to serve as Consulting Teachers for teachers who are participating in the program. Consider applying if you have the following qualifications:

- Credentialed classroom teacher with permanent status
- Minimum of five years of classroom teaching experience
- Taught in the classroom at least three of the last five years
- Last two evaluations effective in all areas
- Demonstrate exemplary teaching ability, effective communication skills, subject matter knowledge, support District curricular goals and standards, and possess a wide range of teaching strategies
- Work cooperatively with your peers and administrators and demonstrate effective leadership skills

If you answered yes to the above criteria, you may be eligible to become a PAR Consulting Teacher. The district will host two informational meetings to provide guidance to teachers who wish to become PAR Consulting Teachers. If interested please attend one of the following sessions:
