SCAMP Camp is a unique combination of outdoor fun and asthma education. Thanks to round-the-clock medical supervision, parents can rest easy while their children have a great time! Experienced medical staff are on hand 24 hours a day to make sure that each child receives appropriate treatment for his or her asthma. The medical volunteers include registered nurses, respiratory therapists, and doctors who specialize in asthma and allergies.

To be accepted to SCAMP Camp, the family must complete an application before the deadline on **May 15, 2009**. A portion of the application must also be completed by the child's healthcare provider. Fees are variable according to family size and income, and scholarships are available so that no child is turned away. (Fees include all meals, transportation, and medical care.)
