Standley has 46% of its population that qualifies for free and reduced lunch. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Similar to this year's scenario, \$197/student that qualifies; Standley gets \$122,337 Every student across district receives same amount, \$344/ student that qualifies; Standley gets \$213,624 Elementary schools require 40% Title I and middle schools require 60% Title I; Standley gets no money Every school receives the same amount of money, Elementary and middle schools require 60% Title I; Standley gets no money A sliding scale starts at 40%, \$190/ student that qualifies; Standley gets \$117,990 Recommendation for DAC Rep: 1st choice- Option #2, 2nd choice- Option #1
